Welcome to Waste Pro! Starting May 1st, Waste Pro will proudly start as the City of High Springs' waste collection service provider.



Your new **Solid Waste collection** days are either
Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday

Use your new solid waste cart (green body, blue lid) starting on **May 1st, 2023.**

Recycling collection day is Friday

Use your new recycling cart (blue body, green lid) starting on **May 1st, 2023.**



Yard Waste collection day is Wednesday

Please use your own container for loose debris and not Waste Pro Containers.

Carts will be delivered between **April 18th and April 30th.**

PROPER PLACEMENT

- Do not block driveways or sidewalks.
 - Position cart with front facing the street.
 - Don't place any carts near power or utility lines.
 - Place carts 3 feet away from cars, trees and mailboxes.
 - Place your containers curbside the night before your collection date.
 - Do NOT use plastic bags for yard waste.
 - Please use your own container for loose debris such as leaves and palm fronds - do not use Waste Pro carts.
 - Yard waste piles should be no bigger than 6 feet long, 4 feet wide, 3 feet in height. Branches can be no longer than 6 feet and diameter no wider than 6 inches.
 - Bulk items will be picked up weekly on the same day as solid waste. No more than 3 bulk items per week. Construction debris is not bulk.
- If you have a white goods item (major metal appliance), please place item by the curb and contact City Hall. They will schedule pickup with Waste Pro.



UNACCEPTABLE SOLID WASTE

- ✗ Tires
- ✗ Paint
- ✗ Electronics
- ✗ Oil, Fuel, Propane
- ✗ Compressed Air/Gas
- ✗ Construction Material
- ✗ Flammable and/or Hazardous materials

UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES

- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Yard Debris
- ✗ Food Waste
- ✗ Clothing
- ✗ Pizza Boxes

UNACCEPTABLE TYPES OF YARD DEBRIS

- ✗ Vacant Lots
- ✗ Storm / Natural disasters debris
- ✗ **ANY** contractor generated debris (construction, landscape, trees, etc...)
