ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION STATEMENT

By signing the application and permit for construction you certify that you have complied, or will comply will alt Federal, State, local laws and regulations pertaining to asbestos. You further understand that any violations of these requirements can result in monetary penalties to the building owners, lessees and their respective contractors. Additional penalties for failing to comply with asbestos rules may include criminal prosecution under federal law and contractor license forfeit/suspension under state law.

Florida Building Code Chapter 1, section 105.9

105.9 Asbestos. The enforcing agency shall require each building permit for the demolition or renovation of an existing structure to contain an asbestos notification statement which indicates the miner's or operator's responsibility to comply with the provisions of Section 469.003 Florida Statute and to notify the Department of Environmental Protection of his or her intentions to remove asbestos, when applicable, in accordance with state and federal law.

State Statute 469.003 License
required.

1. No person may conduct an asbestos survey, develop an operation and maintenance plan, or monitor and evaluate asbestos abatement unless trained and licensed as an asbestos consultant as required by this chapter.
2. No person may prepare asbestos abatement specifications unless trained and licensed as an asbestos consultant as required by this chapter.
3. Any person engaged in the business of asbestos surveys prior to October 1, 1987, who has been certified by the - Department of Labor and Employment Security as a certified asbestos surveyor, and who has complied with the training requirements of s. 469.013, may provide survey services as described in s. 255.553. The Department of Labor and Employment Security may, by rule, establish violations, disciplinary procedures, and penalties for certified asbestos surveyors.
 - a. No person may conduct asbestos abatement work unless licensed by the department under this chapter as an asbestos contractor, except as otherwise provided in this chapter.
