

Abducted Missouri Children Found

On February 1, 2023, at approximately 5:17 pm, HSPD located two abducted Missouri children and their abductor after a routine vehicle tag check indicated the vehicle owner was a fugitive.

Officers located the trio shopping in Winn Dixie after disguising their identities. (The mother gave a false name to LEO) The noncustodial mother, Kristi Nicole Gilley, DOB 01-01-1987, was detained and arrested on an active kidnapping warrant out of Clay County, Missouri.



The children were turned over to the Florida Department of Children and Families Services and will be reunited with their family. These children and their abductor were passing through the area and had no residency connection to Alachua County, Florida, nor were they enrolled in any schools.


