Our SRO's focus is on rapport building, attitude change, counseling, and resource assistance. In the event that a crime occurs on school grounds, the SRO will be responsible for taking appropriate law enforcement action. The HSPD SRO Program currently consists of three school resource officers, two assigned to High Springs Community School and one to First Christian Academy.
