Any vote-by-mail requests on file with the Alachua County Supervisor of Election's office WILL NOT automatically qualify you to receive vote-by-mail ballots in this election.

The deadline for a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the SPECIAL ELECTION is March 14, 2024.

Requests must include your:

- name
- current legal residence address (no post office boxes)
- · date of birth
- last four digits of Social Security Number or full Florida Driver's License/ Florida ID number (whichever is on file)
- signature (the form must be signed, no electronic signatures).

If you previously registered to vote in Alachua County but have now moved elsewhere so that you no longer make your home in this City/County, you should no longer be registered here and should update your voter registration with the election office in the county or state where you now have your legal residence.

On the other hand, if you will not be at your residence address to receive the ballot because you are merely temporarily away, you must provide a mailing address for the ballot. Vote-By-Mail ballots cannot be forwarded by the US Postal Service.
